

What are bylaws?

Bylaws are the rules that govern the management of a non-profit organization.

Bylaws are written by the organization's founders and cover such topics as;

- organizational purpose
- board structure
- officer position descriptions and responsibilities
- terms of board service
- officer/board member succession and removal
- how meetings are conducted
- membership provisions and voting rights.

What are Restrictions?

The restrictions are basically what the association allows in our neighborhood. Their intentions are to keep the neighborhood a clean and safe environment and limit what is and is not allowed. Restrictions are a set of basic guidelines in which our neighborhood abides by. Typical topics are: mowing the yard, garbage cans and fences.
