Financial Review

- A financial review was completed by an outside firm for the fiscal year of April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019.
- On May 29, 2019, B.W. Smith + Company, CPA, PC reported the financial audit results with no findings; meaning we are operating in compliance.
- The next review will occur for the fiscal year April 1, 2019 to March 31, 2020. This will be scheduled and planned to be performed later this year.
- We will continue the annual financial review practice by an outside firm to ensure continued compliance with the Bylaws.

Board and committee reports:

Pond

- Water quality testing is planned to be performed in Mid-April, June, & August.
- Water treatment is planned to be performed as needed.
- New pond safety and information signs were installed.

Restrictions

GreenOakTownship Ordinances

As township ordinances are improved and updated, it makes sense to review our HOA documents. By aligning our restrictions document with the ordinances, the township would become responsible for the cost and any litigation that may result from a violation.

<u>Sub</u> 1

The "Trailer, Trucks, Commercial Vehicles" section has been discussed by the board in an effort to more closely align with the current township ordinances. A proposal to the Sub 1 membership is planned for later this year for their consideration and potential vote.

Sub 2

Discussions by the board are continuing in order to re-evaluate the previous restrictions proposals and to encourage Sub 2 membership participation in future voting.



Front Entrance

Summary of the Plan

- Reface the monuments and replace the signs at two locations.
 - The western side of Ponderosa and eastern side of Daleview monuments will be refaced and the signs replaced.
 - The two monuments will be adjusted so they are similar in size. New signs are planned to be installed onto the top platform.
 - The trees will be trimmed, as needed, and fresh plants will be planted.
 - Fresh mulch will be installed to compliment the monument and sign colors.
 - The lighting will remain as is. LED bulbs are being considered to reduce utility costs.
- Remove the monuments from the eastern side of Ponderosa and western side of Daleview along with their respective ground covering. Grass seed will be planted.

Spring Cleanup

- We have a contract for the front entrance monument cleanup.
- We are scheduling the cleanup and removal of additional fallen trees in the park areas, as appropriate.

Roads

- The roads are not owned by and are not the responsibility of the Oakwood Meadows Association.
- The board followed through from a request from the members to work with the township/county to seek a remedy for the roads.
- Per the township's direction, the Association assessed the interest level from the members for the township to proceed to the next step.
- Based upon the survey result from the members, there was not close to enough support from the membership.
- We encourage the membership to contact the township directly on the street conditions.



Member Event

The 2019 Meet & Greet was held at Aubree's in mid-September. Around 25-30 members and their families attended.

- Boneless wings, bread sticks, Feta bread platter, vegetable platter, and cookies were provided by the board.
- Soft drinks, iced tea, and coffee were provided by the Board.
- Members could purchase alcoholic drinks separately. The event was enjoyed and well received by all whom attended

For 2020

A similar event is planned.

- Tentatively scheduled for fall 2020.
- Tentatively scheduled for Aubree's again, but other venues would be considered if members prefer.
- An invite newsletter will be sent to all members about a month before the event. In addition, an announcement will be posted on the website.



Ballot Results

53 ballots were received, and the following were duly elected:

Gary Buch - 40 John Long – 42 Bradley Oyster - 44 Mark Zemko - 44

The proposed dues of \$150 had 50 Yes votes and 0 No Votes Passed

The monument fund had 43 Yes votes and 6 No Votes. Passed



Member Discussion:

About Sub 1 possible restriction update

Question

How would the change effect the current restrictions document? More restrictive?

Answer from Jim (summary)

It would not be more restrictive. The township has a more detailed definition of what trailer, trucks, and commercial vehicles are.

About Roads

Question

Would it be possible to replace specific sections of the subdivision roads? Has this been discussed with the township?

Answer from Jim (summary)

Once the township is back working in a normal capacity, the board will make an inquiry with the township to see if anything can be done about replacing or repaying specific sections of the HOA roads.

About Landscaping Contract

Question

Did the board get multiple bids for landscaping before selecting Lightning (current vendor)?

Answer from Jim (summary)

Last year, we obtained bids before selecting Lightning. Due to the current viral outbreak. Lightning has agreed to do the initial grass cutting this year. The board is planning to obtain bids for this year's groundskeeping work as businesses come back to work.
